



RULES FOR 2017 12HRS OF HAMMERSTEIN

Race Description:

The Hammerstein 12hr is a long,hard, mean Moto Endurnace Race.

The Word Endurance definition says it all:

The fact of power of enduring an unpleasant or difficult process or situation without giving way.

The capacity of something to last or to withstand wear and tear.

The fact or power of enduring or bearing pain,hardships. The ability or strength to continue or last, especially despite fatigue,stress or other adverse conditions.

CAUTION: Racers need to come to this event fit and ready to endure very hard physical endurance. Long hours on your bike is very, very inportant for your training. Camelbak are recommend durning this event. Drink, Drink, Drink !!!

- Lites B 122ccand over 2-stroke or 4 stroke
- Vet B 122cc-open
- Vet B 30+ 122cc- open
- 40+B 122cc-open
- 50+B 122cc-open

- Open C 251cc and over 2-stroke or 4-stroke
- Lites C 122cc -250cc 2 -stroke or 4-stroke
- 60+ 122cc-open
- Women 122cc-0pen
- 50+C 122cc-open
- 40+C 122cc-open
- Juniors 12-17 100cc-200cc

RIDER ELIGIBILITY AND CLASSIFICATION for all solos and Team class.

A-CLASS

1. All riders in the top 10 overall series ranking in any regional, state or national off-road series the previous year.
2. Former American ISDE Trophy, Junior, or Club team members, excluding the Women/ Masters/ Golden Masters Class.
3. Racers who compete in an A-level class in any other series, regardless if the series is AMA sanctioned.

B-Class

1. Racers who compete in the B-Level class in any series, regardless if the series is AMA sanctioned.
TEAM CLASS: 2 person and 4-person teams
(2 person team can have 1 Pro and 1 A rider or two Pro)
(Teams can have 2 pro riders and 2- A riders or 4 Pro riders) There can be no B or C class riders in the Pro open class.

Solo Class:

- Pro Open 122cc-Open
- Open A 251cc and over 2-stroke or 4-stroke
- Open A Vet 45+ 122cc-open
- Open B 251cc and over 2-stroke or 4-stroke
- Open B Vet-45+ 122cc-open
- Open C 251cc and over 2-stroke or 4-stroke
- Open C Vet-45+ 122cc-open.
- Juniors 12-17 122cc-open

(Juniors must have a parent there to sign off on waiver) Juniors must be 12 years of age by August 19th, 2017. Juniors must be not over the age of 17 by August 17th, 2017. Juniors team must have at least two adults in their pits during the 12hrs of Hammerstein.

PROPER CLASS SELECTION

1. Racers are required to race in the ability level that they typically compete in at the local and/ or national level, regardless if the series/events are AMA sanctioned. The only exception is riders who race locally as a Pro but compete in AA or A classes at the national Enduro or GNCC Series. Any racer who has competed in the XC1 or XC2 classes in the previous or current year must race Pro class.

Starting Order: Classes will be ordered to start line in this order: all classes will start one minute apart.

1. 8:00am Solos. Two-person teams
2. 8:01am 4 person Teams
3. 8:03am Juniors Solos, Junior teams

The Course:

The cross county course will have everything from Enduro, motocross, desert racing. There will be fire roads, double track, single track, pasture areas, shade brush, rock gardens, logs, heavily wooded areas, jumps.

Many parts of the course will have ribbon and wooden stakes, which means DO NOT GO OUTSIDE THE RIBBIONS. Riders caught purposefully riding through ribbon, or over stakes to gain a time

advantage will be given one warning, a second offense will be a 2 minute penalty ,3rd offense will result in DQ of the event. There will be course marshalls out on the course.

We understand that mistakes happen and riders will end up off course due to a crash, miscalculation of trail or course, etc. Riders who go off course cannot make up any time advantage or tear down ribbon or stakes to return to the course.

Race rules:

1. Riders will not be allowed to pre-ride the course. Riders can Mt bike or hike the course on Friday August 18th.
2. Pit riding: Pit riding is prohibited at the Hammerstein 12hrs event. Riders can ride to the start of the event in 1st gear only.
3. Pit crews: Riders are responsible for the actions of their entire pit crew. Drunkness and fighting is 100% Prohibited !! Any one person breaking these rules will be asked to leave the event.
4. Medical Insurance: Hammerstein 12 hr Moto Endurance Championships does not provide medical insurance for competitors, and we urge you not to compete without it. Medical insurance is the sole responsibility of the competitor.
5. Last lap Rule : for the last lap to count riders must be in by 8:00pm. any rider in after the cut-off time lap will not count .Again start times are all one minute apart.

6. Medical: There will be a Medical staff on duty during the event.
7. Racers are allowed to have a one back up bike. Bike must meet the rules and be within the same class CC classification.
8. Each solo rider and 2 person team will be allowed 1-10x10 pop-up tent on Pit row. Each 4 person team will be allowed only 1- 10x20 pop-up tent on pit row.
(Take note that pit row and camping area are not the same) They are both within walking distance.
9. Try to keep the pit area 10x10 tent to only teammates, mechanic, Fuel, ice chest, water.

Awards for the following:

Top 5 in each class

- Fastest lap
- Best young Rider
- Balls of Steel award
- Most giving rider

(Definition : Whn a rider the takes time to stop and help another rider in need)
